What is a Trusted Digital Repository (TDR)?

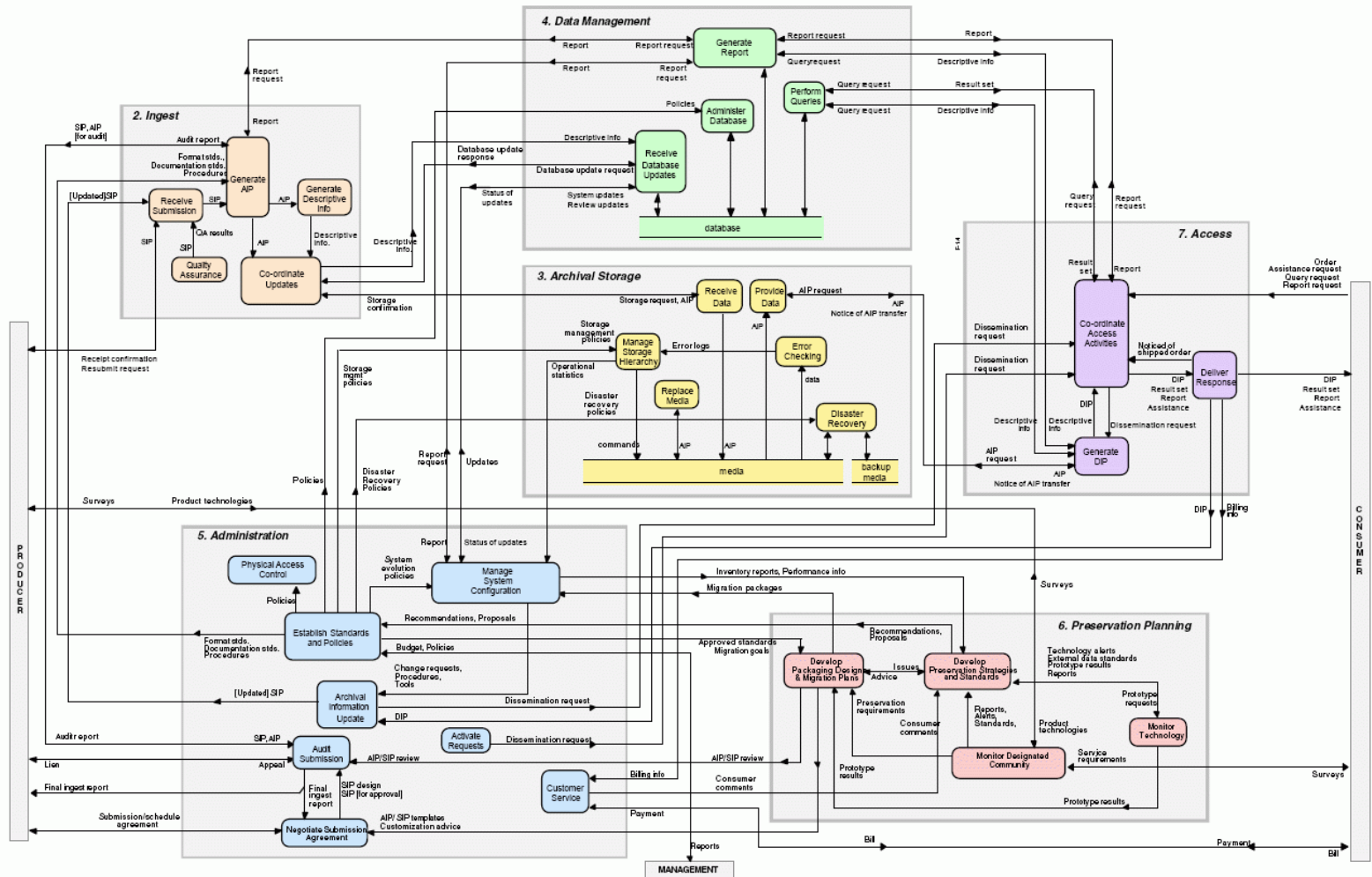

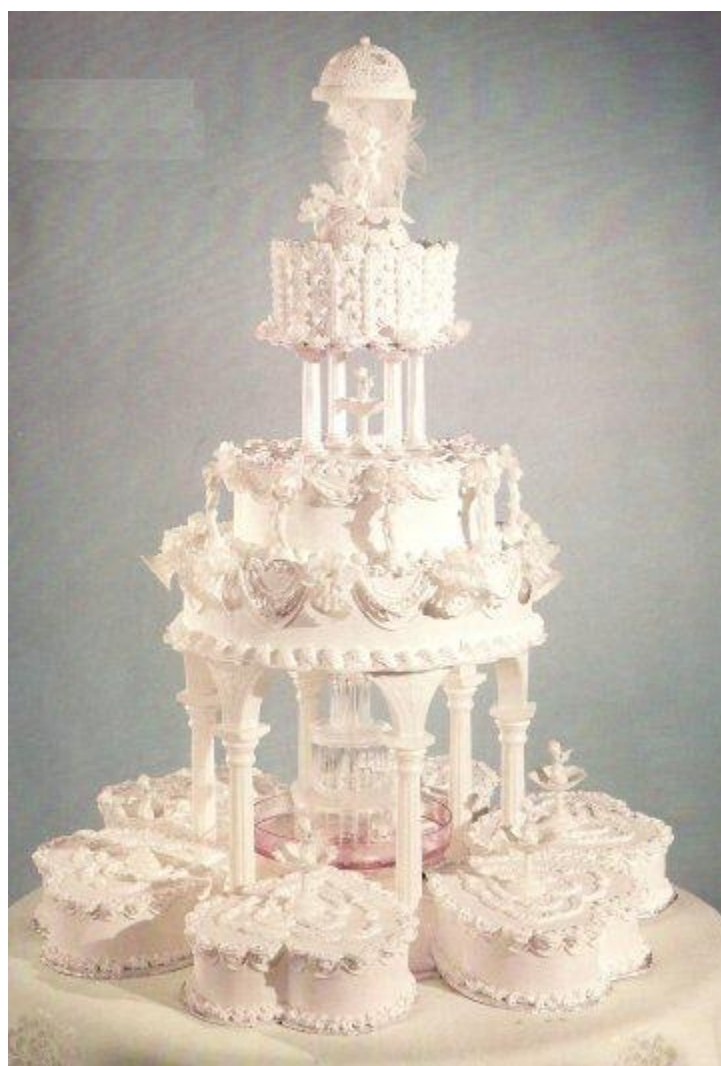
