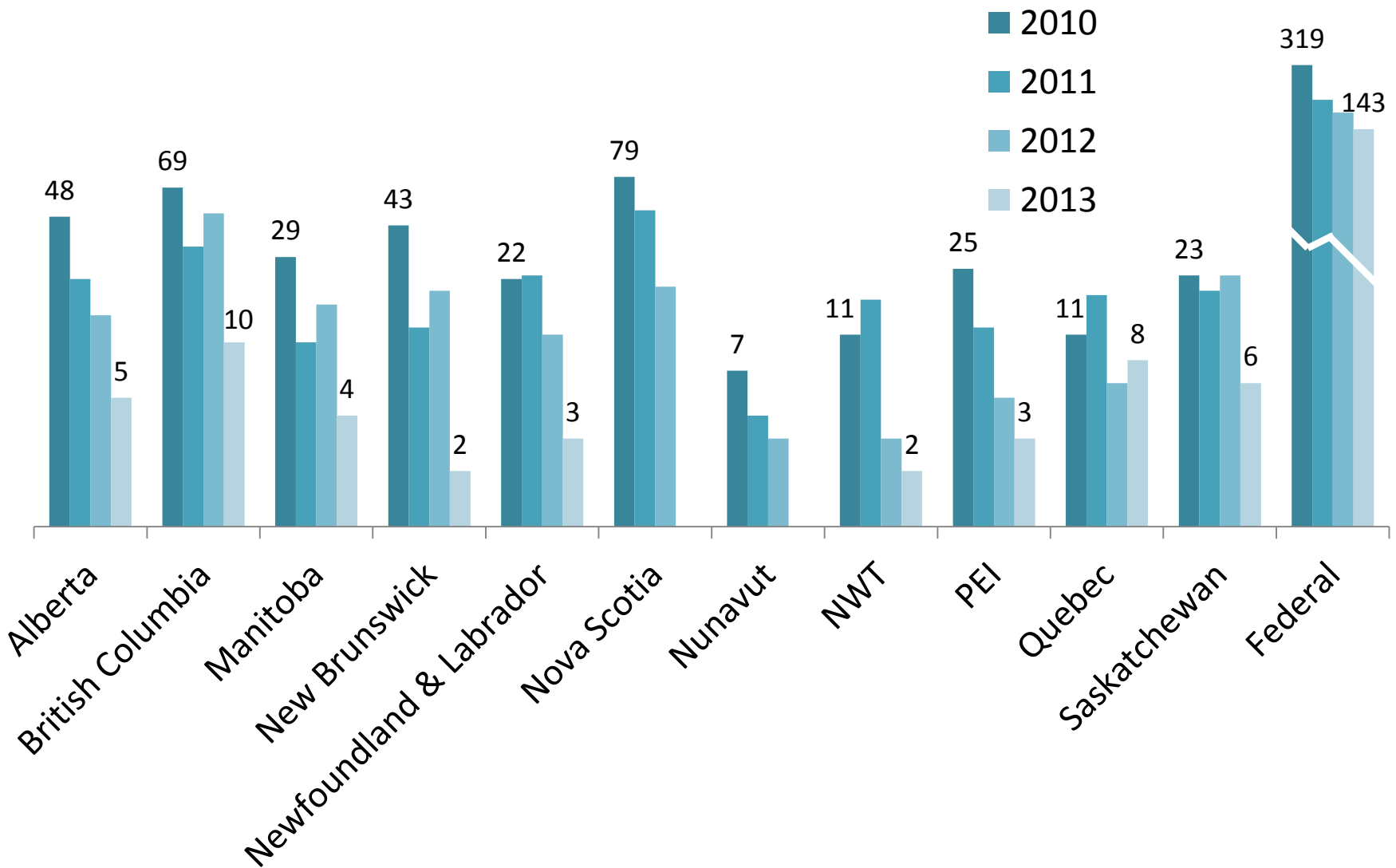

- Low cost

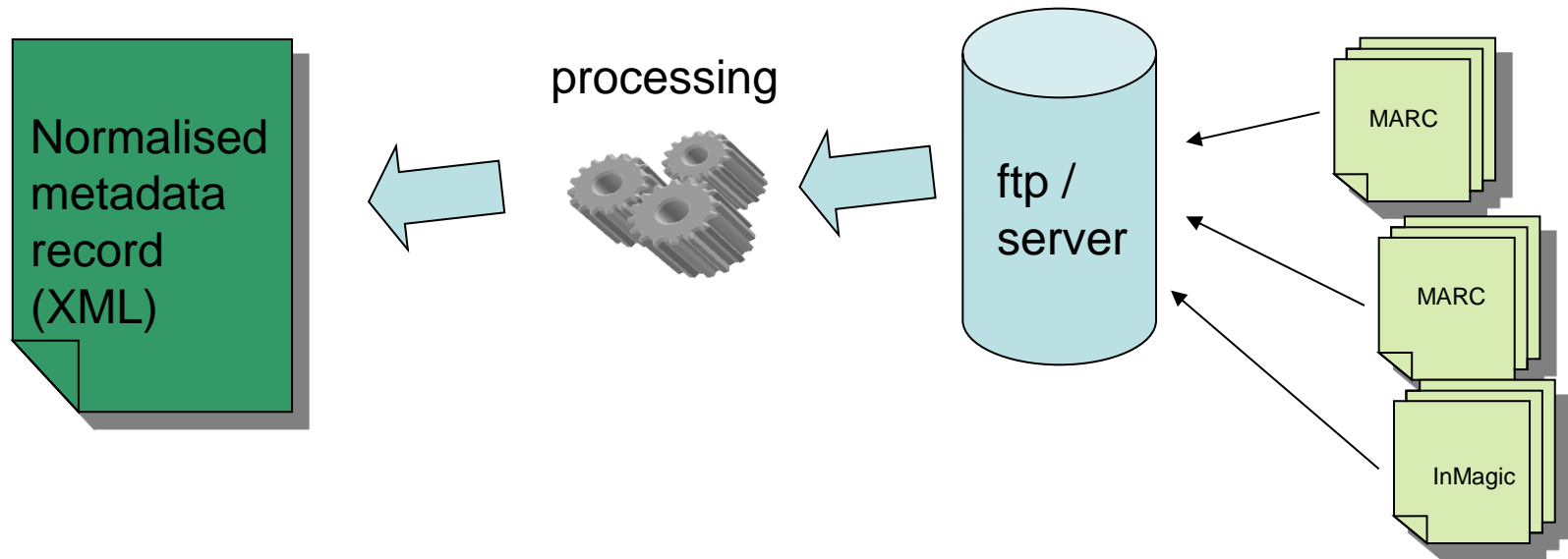
New non-Ontario Government document titles added

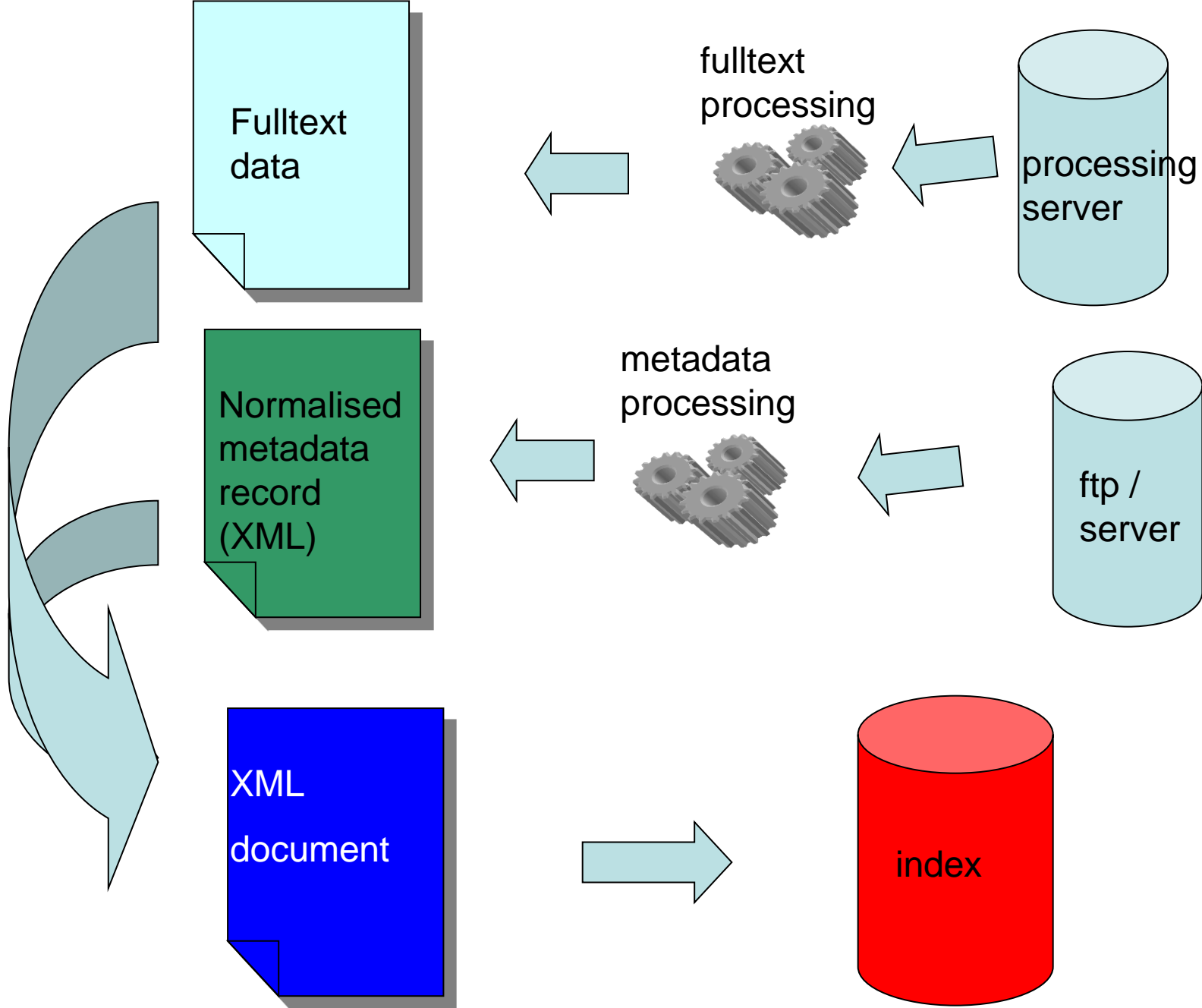


How did we get here?
